There are 4 sections of the Bid Bulletin:

1. **Section I - Prime Requests for DBE Quotes** - Specific requests by Prime Contractors asking for bids on specific projects. These will be listed in individual boxes.
2. **Section II - Past Projects Information** - Projects that have been “let” in the past week. This will allow you continual access to the information so you can call, find out who was awarded the project and see if they are still looking for prices that you can provide. In the future, we hope to have a listing for each contract that will show who was awarded the contract, contact information and the dollar amount of the bid. Note: projects will be moved on Fridays
3. **Section III - Current Projects with Bid Dates** - Current Bids - this section contains project information for jobs that are up for bid. These projects are listed in ascending date order. The projects that are closest in date to being bid or that have no date, are listed in the beginning.
4. **Section IV - Future Planned Projects** - Future Bids - this section contains projects that are still in the planning stage or that do not have definite bid dates at this time. When a date for letting the project is determined, the project will be moved to Section III.

The CDA Bid Opportunity link is an Adobe Acrobat file that can be downloaded to your system using the FREE Adobe Reader. If you don't have the Reader, please call WBC and we will tell you how to obtain this software free of charge. This is critical software if you plan on doing business with the government.

After the file has been downloaded and is on your computer, you can save the file to your computer for future reference, print it or simply view it for projects that you may be interested in bidding on.

However, please note - this file is updated on a regular basis. When a project is located, WBC staff adds it to the existing Bid Bulletin and it is uploaded to the CDA website. We realize that you don't want to scroll through 17 pages of projects, that is what the date of entry is for. The date of entry tells you when this project was put in the Bid Bulletin. If you click on the Binoculars in the icon tool bar, you can enter search criteria - such as the date of entry. For example, if you have viewed the listings up until today (i.e. 5/04/05) and want to see if anything was added today, type in the Search Bar - 5/04/05 and see if there is anything listed with “Date of Entry.” If you aren't able to view it on a daily basis and are only interested in jobs that have painting requirements, for instance, then you can search for “painting.” **The information is updated several times a day - any new projects added after 3:00pm will reflect the next business day's date. Directly following this box will be a date - this date shows the last date and time that this site and projects were updated.**
